This position is responsible for leading in-school drama workshops in South-Western Sydney schools with a focus on working with young people from recent migrant and non-English speaking backgrounds.

An important part of the role will be acting as mentor/teacher to PYT's trainee instructors (Pilots). You will work closely with two trainee teachers per term to develop their skills, providing feedback and planning support throughout the term.

You will be expected to write detailed lesson plans to the established program objectives as outlined by PYT Fairfield.

- Experience working with young people from diverse backgrounds
- Ability to deliver engaging and skills focused drama workshops for young people at various skill levels
